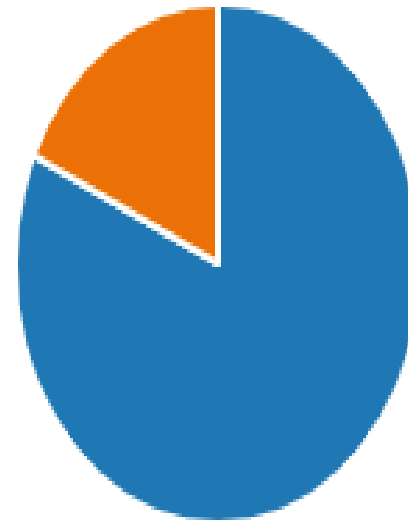

It is a long training day however there is a lot of information so I understand it is hard to shorten.

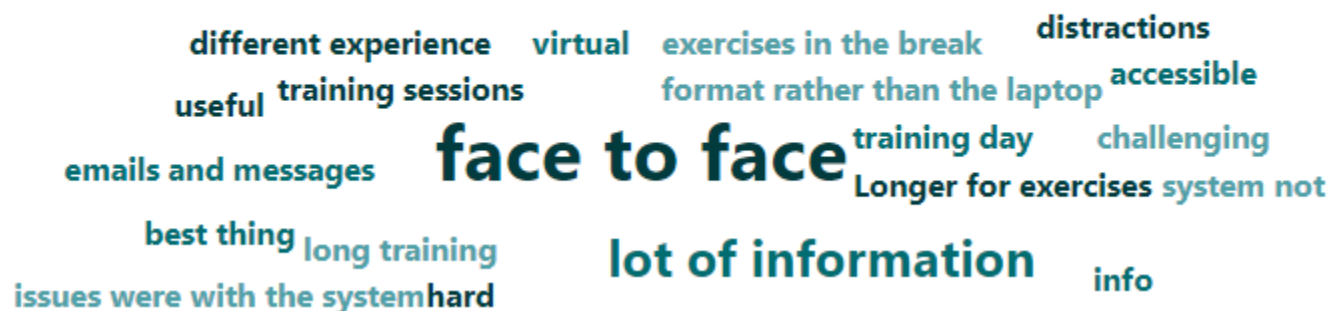

# Some Current Lessons Learnt (we're still learning!)

- MS Teams: Breakout rooms – problematic if you don't generate the link
- Try to embed videos: reduce failed technology
- Try to establish connection and discussion at the beginning to encourage throughout the day
- Need to use less material and more breaks (little and often)
- Can be wider reaching (sharing videos)
- Can save time (self-directed/travel)
- Connection reduced/more spontaneous discussions lost
- Loss of cues and nuances of communication
- Being prepared for virtual delivery (i.e., checking attendees can access before training, reduce distractions etc)
