





Levels of Intervention

Tier 1 intervention provided by Barnardo's Infant Mental Health Key Workers. Includes direct, individualised, educative work on infant development, interventions to support bonding such as baby yoga and massage, support to help parents manage their own regulation and self-care to be better equipped for parenting.

Step Down





Step Up

Tier 2 intervention provide by SEHSCT team staff with additional psychoanalytic training in infant development. Includes interventions listed above, with additional psychotherapeutic focus to address the impact of factors such as intergenerational trauma on parent - infant relationships.

Challenges

- Difficulty of face to face delivery
- Complexity of referrals
- No exit strategies due to lack of services operating
- Additional demands on team re covid eg assisting with vaccinations
- Cost of living crisis poverty
- Ongoing pressure within systems

New innovative ways of working

- Virtual delivery
- Group work
- Outdoor groups
- Easier to meet with others re higher level systems change eg Stronger from the Start


